

## **Itinerary** | Munich, Salzburg & Vienna



Our exploration of these amazing European cities includes time to appreciate the neighborhoods, cuisine, and culture of Germany and Austria, while students flex their navigation, budgeting, and German language speaking skills.

In Munich, students will gain an appreciation of the cultural contributions and the complicated history of the German people, while enjoying the best of Bavarian cuisine. Our journey continues to the Austrian Alps to visit the beautiful city of Salzburg and the surrounding countryside. We also visit Vienna, a city which contrasts the long history of the Habsburg Monarchy with a vibrant, modern atmosphere.

Day	City	Highlights
1	Airborne	Meet your Program Director at the airport for an overnight flight to Germany!
2	Munich	Arrive in Munich and navigate to the hotel using public transportation. Explore the neighborhoods around Marienplatz, the Frauenkirche, and the Neues Rathaus.
3	Munich	Bike tour of Munich led by Mike's Bike Tours, followed by a visit to the Deutsches Museum or the Alte Pinothek in the afternoon.
4	Munich	Visit to the Dachau concentration camp in the morning, then Nymphenburg Palace in the afteroon.
5	Salzburg	Catch an early train to Salzburg! Spend the afternoon exploring the old city and visiting the Hohensalzburg Castle.
6	Salzburg	Head to Bad Dürrnberg to tour the salt mines and enjoy the alpine slide!
7	Vienna	Catch can early train to historic Vienna! Explore the neighborhoods around the Stephansdom, the Staatsoper, and the Danube River.
8	Vienna	Visit Schönbrunn Palace in the morning, then enjoy lunch at the Naschmarkt on the way back to town. Head to the Prater amusement park in the afternoon for rides then dinner.
9	Vienna	Tour the famous Vienna Opera, the catacombs under the Stephansdom, and the Albertiner gallery, then spend the afternoon enjoying the shops and cafés of Vienna.
10	Airborne	Flight home. Auf Wiedersehen Österreich!
